This year, we are proud to reflect on the profound impact your generosity has enabled us to achieve. Through our grants, we have supported nonprofit organizations dedicated to enhancing the mental, physical, spiritual, and emotional well-being of individuals across the 11-county region in central North Dakota. Together, we are fostering healthier, more resilient communities.

At INSPIRITUS Community Health Foundation we believe in empowering organizations that uplift individuals and families. By addressing the interconnected dimensions of well-being—mental, physical, spiritual, and emotional—we aim to create a holistic and lasting impact.

INSPIRITUS Community Health Foundation was able to realize our mission throughout the 2024-2025 year, as well as provide a sense of hope and joy to people in our region through another successful Twice Blessed Campaign.

Because of your generosity through the Twice Blessed Program, your gifts along with Foundation Grants funded more than \$1.5 million for meaningful projects. Foundation Initiative Grants were given to 31 food pantries, with a grant increase of 60% to \$40,000. Eight area youth camps received campership funding, and higher education scholarships provided for students studying in the fields of Nursing, Communication Disorders and Social Work.

\$148,000 in regular grants were also given to organizations in our region to fund: therapy equipment, child passenger safety, employee assistance program, holiday meals for military members, behavioral health for all, and other community program and project needs.

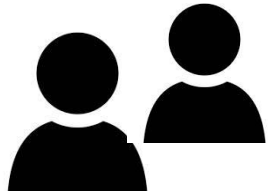
